

SGT Minutes

January 25, 2023

- Members present: Michael Keown, Tonya Hopper, Peter Ott, Jason Scott, Kendrick Maxwell, and Karen Keane
- The SCHS School Governance Team met at 12:00; Peter Ott called the meeting to order.
- KM made a motion to approve the October minutes; it was seconded by KM and unanimously approved.
- Michael Keown presented an administration update
 - Reviewed school goals and the progress towards reaching those goals:
 - 1) Increase the number of proficient and distinguished scores on the American Literature EOCs by 5%. 1st semester scores revealed an increase from 31% to 34%. 73% passed the test.
 - 2) Increase the number of proficient and distinguished scores on the Alegbra 1 EOC by 5%. 1st semester revealed a drop from 21% last year to 10% this year. Scores did decrease across the entire state.
 - 3) Decrease the number of students with 15 or more absences by 5%. 1st semester had 22% fewer attendance marks that the same time last year.
 - At the end of the 1st semester, there were 142 unearned credits (50 of which are eligible for credit recovery). At the same time last year, there were 222 unearned credits.
 - Freshman Fest was successful. Almost 700 people attended.
 - There is a “Life Day” scheduled in March. Students will travel to different rooms to learn various real-life skills.
 - Pam Hill retired as CTAE director. Interviews are set to begin in early February.
 - Central office is holding a job fair to get ahead of the teacher shortage.
 - Kasy Ivey was named as the new softball coach.
 - The new 2023-24 calendar was approved. There is a copy posted on the school system website.
- The next meeting will be on February 22, 2023.
- Peter Ott motioned to adjourn the meeting. KK seconded the motion; it was unanimously approved.
